- \$8 Mini Potato Pancakes** and applesauce, sour cream and caramelized onions
- \$10 Traditional Bratwurst** on a Pittsboro Bread Shop hoagie roll with beer braised sauerkraut, German mustard, and a side of German Potato Salad
- \$12 Bavarian Salad & Cheese Sampler** - Carrot horseradish salad, cucumber dill salad, caraway marinated red and white cabbage, German potato salad, German pickles, sliced Swiss and Brie, and served with local bread
- \$11 O'Batza** - Biergarten style beer cheese spread of Camembert, blue cheese, smoked paprika and lager beer, served with sliced pickles, radishes, and local bread
- \$12 Allgauer Kasspatzle** - Hand-cut German noodles tossed with Emmentaler cheese and caramelized onions, served with cucumber dill salad, caraway marinated red and white cabbage, and horseradish carrot salad
- \$12 Weiner Schnitzel Sandwich** - Breaded pork tenderloin cutlet on a brioche roll with thyme and rosemary aioli, lettuce and tomato. Served with a side of German potato salad and marinated cucumbers
- Bavarian Sausage Platter** - Choice of traditional Bratwurst or Kielbasa over beer braised sauerkraut and served with German potato salad, local bread, horseradish and sweet mustards
- \$12 for 1 Sausage, \$14 for 2 Sausages, and \$16 for 3 Sausages**
