## Registration Requirements

- All dogs must be Dachshunds. Sorry no mix breed allowed
- Proof of rabies vaccination current as of the date of the event and must be included with the registration.
- No registration fee is required. Free entry in included for 1 adult for each dog registered. Additional adults must purchase a separate entry ticket. Kids under 16 are free.
- All dogs must be accompanied by a responsible person at least 18 years of age. During the races, exactly 1 person must be at the start line and exactly 1 person must be at the finish line.
- All responsible persons must show ID (even if not drinking alcohol) and sign a liability waiver before entering the venue.


## Owner Certifications and Liability Release

a) I am at least 18 years of age or will have a legal guardian present.
b) I will not hold any Rotary Club organization, the Town of Cary, Booth Amphitheatre, or any event sponsor responsible or liable for (i) any injury to my dog, or (ii) any cost incurred for misbehaved dogs, accidents, or injuries as a result of this event.
c) My dog is current on all required vaccines and will wear a name tag.
d) I agree that I am responsible for controlling my dog at all times and I will pick up after my dog.
e) I agree to keep my dog on a leash except when racing.
f) I agree to allow any photo or video of me or my dog taken during the race or parade to be published and/or used in marketing future Triangle Oktoberfest events.

## OFFICIAL RULES Triangle Oktoberfest Wiener Dog Races



1. All dogs must Dachshunds or more affectionately a sausage dog. Sorry no mix breed allowed . . . just not fair to compete with Dorkies, Dorgles, and Goldenshunds.
2. Proof of rabies vaccination current as of the date of the event and must be provided with registration.
3. No registration fee is required. Free entry in included for 1 adult for each dog registered. Additional adults must purchase a separate entry ticket. Kids under 16 are free.
4. All dogs must be accompanied by a responsible person at least 18 years of age.
5. All responsible persons must show ID (even if not drinking alcohol) and sign a liability waiver before entering the venue.
6. The responsible person (not 1 of our volunteers) must clean up after their dog! And please keep your dog on a leash except, of course, within the race arena.
7. No more and no less than 2 people must be available during the race $\ldots 1$ at the start and 1 at the finish. One of these people may be a kid.
8. You may use a toy or treat to entice your dog, but you must stay behind the finish line until your dog comes to you. The toy or treat may not be thrown or tossed.
9. You may not run along beside the dog for the safety of the other dogs and quite frankly yourself. So many kids will be surrounding the race arena.
10. If you touch your dog before completely crossing the finish line, your dog will be disqualified. Please, please follow this rule because it is really awkward for our volunteers to DQ a dog.
11. All race judge decisions are final. Again, we are all volunteers trying to do good things for charity.
12. Please have FUN!

FYI . . . THE same registration and entry rules apply to the Wiener Dog Parades. THERE WILL BE A PARADE AFTER BOTH THE 2 PM RACE AND THE 5 PM RACE. Again, it's all about having FUN!
